What is WEC Trek?

Trek organises short-term mission with WEC International, which exists to see Christ known, loved and worshipped by the least-evangelised peoples of the world. Our 1,800 workers serve among 90 of the least-reached people groups.

What is Trek's goal?

To fuel your passion for Jesus by providing cross-cultural mission experience.

Who should apply?

You, if you are over 18 years old and have:

- a growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- a servant heart
- a flexible attitude

Do you contact my home church?

Yes. It's important that your church is encouraging you and praying for you. We will require a church reference, regardless of how long you plan to go.

Where will I stay?

In the homes of WEC workers or local people, or in guest houses.

Will I study another language?

As much as possible! During orientation we teach you to make the most of language-learning opportunities. You may already speak a national language, but might like to start to learn a local or tribal language.

How much does it cost?

You are responsible for the costs, which vary depending on where you go and how long you stay. These include return ticket to the country, insurance, board and lodging, internal travel, essential vaccinations, orientation and debrief.

How do I apply and when do I start?

Contact us now! The application takes a minimum of three months. The sooner you get started the better. Teams have fixed deadlines, so please enquire early to avoid disappointment.

What does WEC provide?

WEC is with you every step of the way.

- preparation including a 4-day orientation course
- discipleship material for study and reflection
- mentoring
- debrief
- 3-month follow-up programme to keep your sights on God
