WHAT'S IN THE PROGRAMME?

We will share joint Bible teaching sessions led by Alistair Wilson who is a lecturer at the Edinburgh Theological Seminary. The weekend runs concurrently with the WEC prayer weekend. We will also hear from mission partners with recent first hand experience and have the opportunity to interact and ask questions.

FRIDAY

Arrive by 6:30pm for an evening meal.
Evening session: The world right now.

SATURDAY

Morning sessions: God's heart for the nations and how to pray more effectively for the world.
Afternoon: free time. Evening: cross-cultural experience.

SUNDAY

Morning worship service. Session: Where to now?
Opportunity for informal sharing with those who have cross-cultural experience; time to reflect and pray.

How much does it cost?
