It is operated by the Berea Trust, with the aim of providing a good quality and affordable Christian centre for fellowship and outreach. The Windmill is managed by Amy Stalker, and has undergone major upgrading over the past few years.

The centre offers a range of en-suite bedrooms, as well as lounge and dining areas and a children's play and activity area.

There is onsite parking.
